Pullman's 39th annual Fourth of July celebration will be held in Sunnyside Park.

The event will begin at 5 p.m. with a barbecue, and novelties and treats will be sold to support the event. The Community Band of the Palouse will perform from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., followed by a musical performance by Dan Maher from 6:30 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. The Fabulous Kingpins will play until the fireworks show begins around 10 p.m.

Pullman Transit will offer free rides to and from Sunnyside Park. Beginning at 4:15 p.m. the A, Loop and South routes will detour to Sunnyside Park at the end of each loop. Pullman Transit will also operate additional A and Loop routes beginning at 9:50 p.m.

Sunnyside Park is located south of Highway 270 where traffic enters Pullman from Colfax.
